Varietals:	Shiraz (Small amounts Pinot Noir & Merlot)
Technical	11.5% Alc/Vol
Specifications:	3.2 pH 6.4 TA 6.8 g/l Sugar
Appearance:	Rose
Aromas:	A blend of raspberries and black berries evident.
Palate:	Delicate berry flavours with a hint of cherries. A light bodied style best served chilled to maintain flavours and freshness on the palate. Would suit all light styles of cuisine, especially Italian foods. A little spritz added
Cellaring:	Made for early consumption.
Back Label Text:	This rose wine was made from Shiraz grapes where the juice was left in contact with the skins for 7 hours. It has a fresh raspberry and cherry aroma with hints of blackcurrants. This wine should be consumed slightly chilled (10–12°C). It has been bottled under Stelvin closure to retain the fresh fruit characters and to ensure that the wine is not affected by any possible cork taint.
